To be considered for this Poster Session, the applicant must...

- Be conducting research in alignment with the Symposium.
- Be within eight years of completing terminal degree (must have completed in 2016 or later).
 Residents, including chief residents, are eligible.

Application Process

The applicant must email the following as a single PDF to Gen Hood, <u>ghood@auanet.org</u> and <u>research@auanet.org</u> by <u>Friday</u>, <u>March 8th</u>, <u>2024</u>.

Required:

- 1. Applicant information (fillable PDF below)
 - Must include: name, credentials, institution, professional title, AUA ID number (if applicable), email address, mobile phone number, mailing address, date terminal degree completed, and demographic information
- 2. <u>Abstract</u> (one page maximum) of the project along with the title of the research project in alignment with the Symposium.
 - a. Abstracts can include pictures, graphs, or charts (3 images maximum)
 - b. Source citations are not required.
- 3. An NIH-style biosketch of the applicant (five-page maximum), in accordance with current NIH biosketch guidelines located at http://grants.nih.gov/grants/forms/biosketch.htm
- 4. A personal statement (one paragraph maximum) from the applicant that:
 - a. affirms their desire and commitment to participate and present their research project during the Symposium Poster Session, and
 - b. confirms their research is in alignment with the Symposium.

Optional:



5. A <u>letter</u> (1 page maximum) from the applicant's primary mentor that emphasizes the alignment with the Symposium topic.

Poster Presenter Review and Selection

Selection of abstract presenters is based on the review of all submitted information and is conducted by a committee of external experts in urologic research appointed by the AUA Office of Research. Final determination is at the sole discretion of the AUA Office of Research.

Poster Presenter Notification

Applicants selected to present their posters during the Poster Session portion of the selected Symposium will be notified no later than Monday, April 1st, 2024.

- Monday, April 1st, 2024: Selected poster presenters will be notified and invited
